YOUR VOTE COUNTS!

Recently, some shocking information about the 2016 Presidential election caught my eye. A potential 102 million votes were squandered because they were not cast. The largest simple bloc of voters in that election was neither the Republican bloc nor the Democrat bloc. It was the non-voter bloc comprised of almost 42% of all eligible voters. If more non-voters had exercised their right to take part in our democratic process, the results of our 2016 Presidential election may have been very different.

You will have a chance to “make a difference” by casting your vote in our midterm elections on Tuesday, November 6. These elections will be the first to be held since the new map reconfiguring many of Pennsylvania’s Congressional Districts was drawn. It is predicted that these changes to the voting districts will lead to many close contests and will possibly transform Pennsylvania’s delegation to Congress this fall.

If you cannot get to the polls, you can obtain an absentee ballot through the office of your State Representative. Contact information for your Representative can be found on page 24 of your blue booklet, “Where to Call for Help in York County.”

Vote on Tuesday, November 6. Claim (or reclaim) your right to choose the leaders who will determine the future of our state and country.
