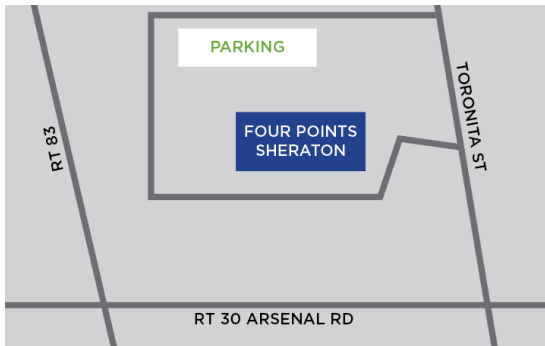

2024 PICK UP LOCATION

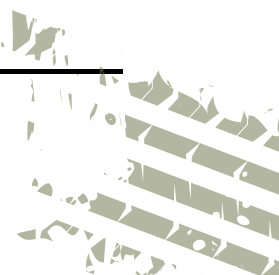
