- A. Balance is \$36,786.53 (General Fund is \$26,661.46; Scholarship Fund is \$7,913.86; Social Service Fund is \$2,211.21).
- B. Joel presented the tentative budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024. After a brief discussion, Joel motioned to accept the tentative budget and Doris seconded. The motion was carried, and Joel will present the budget for final approval at the August 14th Membership Meeting.

President's Report: Chris

- A. Sharon Smith is our new Newsletter Chairperson. A million thanks to Andrea who has done the newsletter for many years. Our membership always received a quality newsletter four times a year thanks to Andrea's time and effort.
