EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT AWARDS

With the continual generous donations to the Scholarship Fund, two \$2,000.00 scholarships are awarded annually to York County high school seniors majoring in education. The Educational Support Committee of YCPASR received 22 applications for the two scholarships awarded this year. Of the seventeen school districts in York County, twelve different districts were represented in the selection process. This year's winners are Mya Maloney, a 2023 graduate of Hanover High School, who will attend Lebanon Valley College to major in Early Childhood Education, and Special Education. She is the daughter of Brad and Vicki Maloney. Julia Ryer, a 2023 graduate of Central York High School will attend Shippensburg University to dual major in Special Education and Elementary Education. She is the daughter of David and Christine Ryer. BASKET RAFFLE






